










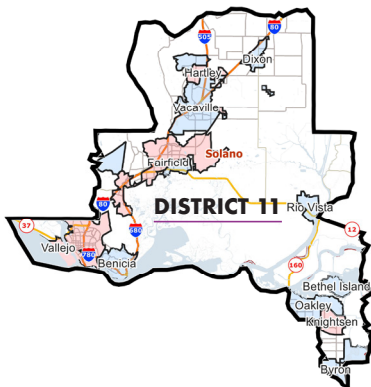
In the April 5th Special Election for Assembly District 11, Lori D. Wilson won the seat vacated by former Assemblymember Jim Frazier. After being sworn in as Solano County’s new Assemblymember on April 6th, Lori has hit the ground running in Sacramento. She serves as the Assistant Majority Whip and is Chair of the Select Committee on Transportation & Emergency Preparedness, Co-Chair of the Delta Caucus and incoming Chair of the Legislative Black Caucus. Her committee assignments include Accountability and Administrative Review, Appropriations, Banking and Finance, Privacy and Consumer Protections and Agriculture.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

In her first legislative session, Lori has delivered for the 11th Assembly District. She secured funding for transitional shelters with wraparound services – helping more homeless get inside. She supported increased school funding to improve student-teacher ratios and keep nurses on staff for student safety and the Middle Class Tax Refund to put \$400 to \$700 in people’s pockets to help fight inflation.

Locally, Lori also secured funding for specific projects that will improve lives in Solano County. They include:

-  \$1,000,000 to the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) for Electric Vehicle Infrastructure in the Cities of Vacaville, Fairfield, Suisun City and Rio Vista.
-  \$1,400,000 to the City of Vacaville for the Vacaville Neighborhood Boys and Girls Club land acquisition and capital projects.
-  \$1,500,000 to the City of Fairfield for Park Upgrades: Linear Park and Allan Witt Park.
-  \$8,600,000 to the Fairfield-Suisun Sewer District for the Kellogg Resiliency Project.
-  \$1,200,000 to the City of Fairfield for the Shelter SOLANO Dining Hall and Kitchen Construction.
-  \$2,500,000 to the City of Suisun for Park Upgrades: Prosperity Gardens and Montebello Vista Park.
-  \$1,500,000 to the City of Suisun City for public safety upgrades.

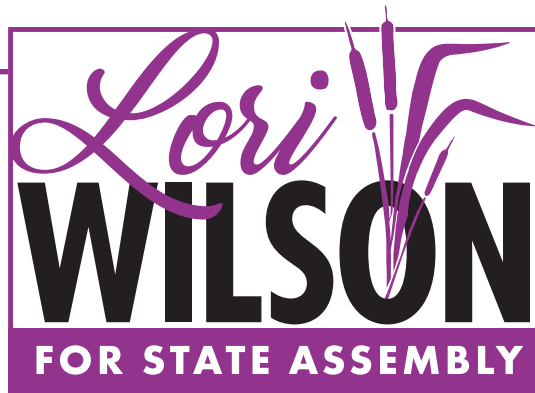

BIOGRAPHY

Lori D. Wilson was sworn into office as the 11th District's new Assemblymember on April 6th after winning the special election following Jim Frazier's retirement. Wilson was appointed to the Accountability and Administrative Review Committee, the Appropriations Committee, the Banking and Finance Committee, and the Privacy and Consumer Protection Committee. Speaker of the Assembly Anthony Rendon also appointed Wilson as Assistant Majority Whip.



Assemblymember Lori D. Wilson proudly represents California's 11th Assembly District. Prior to winning the Assembly seat in April, Lori was the first Black female Mayor to serve in all of Solano County as the Mayor of Suisun City. First elected to the Suisun City Council in 2012, she served as Vice-Mayor for six years before winning the mayor's race in 2018.

During her tenure as Mayor, she worked tirelessly to make Suisun City a welcoming and safe place to call home. She established a track record of fiscal responsibility while leading efforts to bring more housing, jobs and diversity to Suisun City. She is committed

to fighting for the residents of California's 11th Assembly District by creating good jobs, keeping the community safe and improving the quality of life for all her constituents.

Before Lori took office, Lori worked as Director of Finance for national homebuilders for over 10 years and previously held roles as the Chief Accountant at Fair Housing Napa Valley and an Auditor of Solano County.

A native Californian raised on the west side of Fresno, Lori is a graduate of California State University, Sacramento with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Accountancy. She is married to her high school sweetheart Chavares Wilson, a retired Air Force Reserve Technical Sergeant. They have been blessed with two sons, Tyler and Kiren, and a daughter-in-law, Brittney. They have enjoyed living in Suisun City since 2004 after being stationed at Travis AFB for 5 years.
